#### 4. Main fields of research

- Pieter Leroy's research covers social and political aspects of environmental issues. Over the last 25 years his work focused on the analysis and evaluation of newly emerging policy arrangements in the environmental field: new modes of governance, their emergence and functioning, in a context of more encompassing institutional and political changes. The former include new ways of designing organising, decision making, implementation and evaluation e.g. in efforts towards integrated policy making, participatory approaches, stakeholder involvement, 'from environment to sustainability', etc. The latter refer to multi actor and multi level governance, to new interrelations between state, market and civil society, to Europeanisation, globalisation, etc.

Most of his research has been comparative, in three ways. First, between sectors, with institutional and policy analyses in environmental sub-domains ranging from waste management, over water policies, nature conservation and biodiversity, climate change, to energy policies and others. Second, over time, as analyses looked at institutional changes – or the lack thereof – over a few decades. Thirdly, between countries, as the research covered different European member states. Finally, his research focused on cross-sector political topics such as the emergence of sustainability discourses and practices, the institutionalisation of public and stakeholder participation, the role of knowledge and expertise in environmental decision-making, the institutional organisation of the science-policy interface etc.

The (M)UNPOP programme, set up in cooperation with prof. P. Glasbergen, Utrecht University, analysed and evaluated private governance initiatives, such as partnerships, dialogues and other multi-stakeholder initiatives, looked upon as both new modes of environmental governance and as new modes of non-state actors' participation and cooperation.

- Pieter Leroy has a long lasting experience with state of the environment and/or sustainability reporting in Belgium, the Netherlands and France, be it as a researcher, a consultant, a chair or a member of advisory or scientific boards. He contributed to both the underpinning of these reports with data and insights from political analysis and policy evaluation, and the societal and political relevance of these reports. He still is repeatedly invited to contribute to the very design of these reports or to review concept versions thereof.
